Apollyon is a science fiction podcast about a post-pandemic world.

It is the third podcast series from Observer Pictures, an independent short film and podcast production company based in Nashville, Tenn. founded by Faith McQuinn.

It's the 22nd century. The Apollyon virus has torn through the world and wiped out more than half of the population.

Now, a majority of the world is governed by the ICRS, the International Conglomerate of Research Scientists, a group of politicians and scientists working to keep the world as safe as possible. That safety means restricted travel and quarantined cities.

Dr. Theo Ramsey works in the American ICRS headquarters in Atlanta. She and her research partner, Dr. Gabriel Larson, have just discovered an effective vaccine for AVS, but the stakes to get the vaccine to the public are higher than she ever imagined.
